3T MRI

Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) is a method of looking inside the body. Instead of using x-rays, the MRI scanner uses magnetism and radio waves to produce remarkably clear pictures of your head, spine, joints, and other soft tissues of the body. An MRI scanner consists of a strong magnet with a radio transmitter and receiver.

You will feel no pain during the exam. If your doctor has requested, you may need an injection of an IV contrast material to allow better visualization of the internal structures. During the imaging, you will hear repetitive thumping noises coming from the walls of the machine. You will be given hearing protection. You will be asked to hold very still and relax because any movement during the scan will seriously blur the pictures.

No special preparation is needed prior to the exam, unless your doctor has instructed you otherwise. You will be asked to complete a safety screening form and answer questions pertaining to your medical history.

Please wear loose clothing without zippers or metallic parts. You may be asked to change into scrubs (not gowns) to ensure there is no metal to interfere with the scan. You will be asked to remove all jewelry, watches, hairpins, glasses, wallets, and any other metallic object.

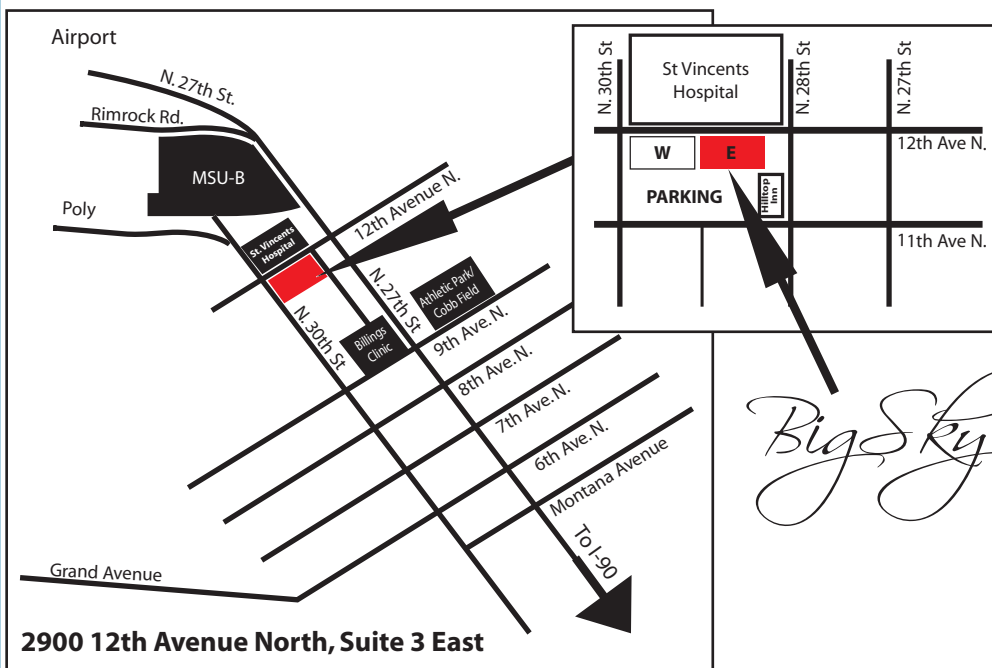
PATIENT INFORMATION
